

Growth Scan - Normal Report

OB -2/3 Trimester Scan Report

Indication(s)

To assess interval growth

Previous Lscs

Realtime B-mode ultrasonography of gravid uterus done.

Route: Transabdominal

Single intrauterine gestation

Detailed fetal anatomical assessment not done in today scan due to advanced gestation and fetal position.

Presentation -Cephalic

Placenta -Posterior

Liquor -Normal

Amniotic fluid index = 13

Fetal activity present

Cardiac activity present

Fetal heart rate -142 bpm

Biometry (mm)

BPD 87, 35W 2D (67%)

HC 308, 34W 6D (58%)

AC 301.71, 36W 2D (83%)

FL-Rt 65, 34W (50%)

Fetal Anatomy

Head appeared normal.

Neck appeared normal.

Spine appeared normal. No evidence of significant open neural tube defect.

Both lungs appeared normal.

Heart -Four chamber view appears normal

Outflow tracts appeared normal.

Abdominal situs appeared normal.

Stomach and bowel appeared normal.

Both kidneys and bladder appeared normal.

Limited limb survey only possible due to advanced gestational age. Visualised portions of the limbs appeared normal.

Impression

Single gestation corresponding to a gestational age of 34 Weeks 1 Day

Gestational age assigned as per LMP

Placenta -Posterior

Presentation -Cephalic

Liquor -Normal

Estimated fetal weight according to BPD,AC :-2454 + / -245.4 BPD,HC,AC,FL :-2345 + / -234.5 gms.

As compared with previous scan, interval growth is satisfactory. Normal

flow across umbilical artery.
